A protagonist is the central character or leading figure in poetry, narrative, novel or any other story.

A protagonist is sometimes called a “hero” by the audience or readers

Antagonist

An antagonist is the adversary (enemy) of the hero or protagonist of a drama or other literary work. The antagonist can be a person, but may also be a force of nature or set of circumstances.

Add to Setting card:

Physical setting includes climate, geography and physical objects

Time can be time in history, time of year, and time of day

Cultural setting can include behavior and beliefs that dominate the society in which the characters live. Family relationships, moral values, political systems, class structures, gender roles and race relations are all part of the cultural environment.
