## COMMAS WITH APPOSITIVES

- Use commas to set off appositives (synonyms) that are non-restrictive.
- Commas are NOT needed if the appositive is a name and is restrictive (required for meaning).

**Practice**: Add a commas where needed in each sentence and <u>circle any commas you add</u>. If a sentence does not need any commas, write "correct" next to the sentence.
