1. *(Suddenly everything else is forgotten as they hear the sound of an automobile coming to a screeching stop in the street below. They are tense, motionless in their terror. The car starts away. A wave of relief sweeps over them. They pick up their occupations again. Anne flings open the door of Peter's room, making a dramatic entrance. She is dressed in Peter's clothes. Peter looks at her in fury. The others are amused)* (463).
2. "There's no reason for you to consult anyone. This is your place. You have a right to do exactly as you please. The only thing I feel... there's so little food as it is... and to take in another person..." (469).
3. "I always get along very well with children. My patients all bring their children to me, because they know I get on well with them. So don't you worry about that" (474).
