

annotate	to make notes about
bibliography	a list of sources used <i>(All sources you consulted but did not necessarily use)</i>
citation	a listing giving credit to a source
cite	to give credit to a source
MLA format	An accepted format used for citing sources and established by Modern Language Association.
note card	method of compiling information on the topic`
paraphrase	to put into your own words
periodical	a newspaper, magazine, or journal
plagiarism	using a source without giving proper credit
primary source	An original document containing the observations, ideas, and conclusions of an individual. It is a firsthand account presented by someone present or actively participating in the event. Examples include manuscripts, photographs, oral histories, and personal journals.

secondary source	Information gathered by someone who did not take part in or witness an event
source	a place to find information
summarize	to reduce a large amount of information
thesis	In expository writing, the thesis statement is the sentence or group of sentences that directly expresses the author's opinion, purpose, meaning, or proposition.
works cited	A list of sources used in a paper by an author when preparing a particular work (Actually cited in paper)
